



## **Zapisnik 35. sjednice Stalne hrvatsko-bavarske komisije**

### **Osijek, 10. i 11. travnja 2025.**

Dana 10. i 11. travnja 2025. godine u Osijeku je održana 35. sjednica Stalne hrvatsko-bavarske komisije pod supredsjedanjem voditeljice izaslanstva Republike Hrvatske, državne tajnice za Europu u Ministarstvu vanjskih i europskih poslova Andreje Metelko-Zgombić, te voditeljice izaslanstva Slobodne države Bavarske, državne ministricice prehrane, poljoprivrede, šumarstva i turizma Michaele Kaniber. Članovi obaju izaslanstava navedeni su u Prilogu 1.

Pozdravljajući tradicionalno bliske i prijateljske odnose između Republike Hrvatske i Slobodne Države Bavarske, državna tajnica Metelko-Zgombić i državna ministrica Kaniber naglasile su važnost uloge koju je Stalna hrvatsko-bavarska komisija igrala u njihovoj izgradnji i kontinuiranom jačanju. Pozdravile su napredak koji je na različitim područjima suradnje ostvaren od održavanja prethodne sjednice u Münchenu 2022. godine.

Supredsjedateljice su se složile da kompleksnost izazova s kojima smo suočeni nameće potrebu dodatnog jačanja kako bilateralne suradnje, tako i suradnje u širem europskom okviru s ciljem izgradnje snažnije i otpornije Europske unije i njezinih država članica. S obzirom na ulogu koju u ostvarivanju tog cilja igra sigurnost energetskih opskrbnih pravaca, podcrtale su važnost projekta povezivanja plinovodnog transportnog sustava od LNG terminala na otoku Krku do Bavarske te njegove kasnije prilagodbe za transport vodika.

Supredsjedateljice su naglasile obostranu spremnost za ulaganje dodatnih napora za očuvanje mira, stabilnosti i prosperiteta na europskom kontinentu. Suglasile su se s potrebom žurnog jačanja europskih obrambenih kapaciteta i nastavkom pružanja potpore Ukrajini. Pozdravile su napore za postizanje mirovnog rješenja, naglašavajući potrebu da se ono temelji na međunarodnom pravu i odredbama Povelje Ujedinjenih naroda. Ukažale su na važnost snažnijeg europskog angažmana u regiji zapadnog Balkana s ciljem očuvanja regionalne i europske stabilnosti te poticanja reformskih procesa koji bi zemlje regije približili Europskoj uniji i osnažili dobrosusjedske odnose i suradnje.

#### **Buduća suradnja**

Izaslanstva su se osvrnula na provedbu radnog programa usvojenog na 34. sjednici 2022. godine u Münchenu te razgovarala o nastavku već uspostavljenih oblika suradnje, kao i o planovima za njezino proširenje na pojedinim područjima. Temelj za buduću suradnju je zajednički radni program u Prilogu 2.

## I. Uprava, policija i pravosuđe

U području suradnje iz nadležnosti unutarnjih poslova iskazano je obostrano zadovoljstvo dosadašnjim sastancima na političkoj razini te potvrđena spremnost za organizaciju budućih sastanaka ministara unutarnjih poslova Republike Hrvatske i Slobodne Države Bavarske. Potpredsjednik Vlade i ministar unutarnjih poslova Davor Božinović bio je u službenom posjetu Bavarskoj u kolovozu 2024., a državni ministar Joachim Herrmann planira službeni posjet Hrvatskoj tijekom 2025. godine.

Dogovoren je nastavak suradnje u području zaštite granice i suzbijanju nezakonitih migracija, kao i razmjena informacija i iskustava te radnih posjeta stručnjaka u području upravljanja katastrofama, zaštite svjedoka i ciljanih potraga te na suzbijanju organiziranog kriminaliteta, uključujući kriminalitet droga.

Nekoliko istaknutih projekata:

- Upućivanje bavarskih policijskih službenika u Hrvatsku unutar projekta Sigurna turistička destinacija
- Suradnja policijskih službenika granične policije Hrvatske i Bavarske kroz razmjenu posjeta i iskustava na suzbijanju nezakonitih migracija, otkrivanju krivotvorenih dokumenata te na provedbi Pakta o migracijama i azilu.

Dogovorena je razmjena iskustava na području modernizacije i razvoja novih digitalnih rješenja na području pravosuđa i javne uprave, što obuhvaća i uvođenje novih elektroničnih usluga za građane i pravne osobe. Također postoji interes za produbljivanjem suradnje na području obrazovanja pravosudnih dužnosnika, poput uključivanje hrvatskih pravosudnih dužnosnika u obrazovne aktivnosti u organizaciji Bavarske te uključivanje stručnjaka iz Bavarske kao voditelja obrazovnih aktivnosti u organizaciji Pravosudne akademije, posebice u području kibernetičkog kriminala te utjecaja umjetne inteligencije u pravosuđu.

## II. Obrazovanje, znanost i kultura

Vezano uz suradnju na području obrazovanja i znanosti, posebno se ističe:

- Projekt osnivanja lektorata hrvatskog jezika i književnosti na Sveučilištu u Regensburgu (Croaticum), koji je započeo s radom u rujnu 2023. godine i koji zainteresiranim studentima nudi sedam različitih kolegija iz područja hrvatskog jezika i književnosti
- Jednotjedni seminar (interkulturni i didaktički aspekti) za hrvatske nastavnice i nastavnike njemačkog jezika na Akademiji za usavršavanje nastavnika u Dillingenu, s mogućnošću hospitacije na bavarskim školama
- Nastavak suradnje u poticanju nastave hrvatskog jezika u Bavarskoj u okviru nastave hrvatskog jezika u inozemstvu za učenike osnovnih i srednjih škola
- Nastavak uspješne suradnje na području visokoškolskog obrazovanja, poput organizacije Bavarsko-hrvatskog dana visokog obrazovanja 2025. u Regensburgu, kao i strateško partnerstvo Sveučilišta u Regensburgu i Sveučilišta u Zagrebu

U području kulture supredsjedateljice pozdravljaju suradnju s Orkestrom i Zborom bavarske radiotelevizije, koja je u razdoblju od 2019. godine rezultirala s deset održanih

koncerata, a bit će nastavljena svečanim koncertom na Dubrovačkim ljetnim igrama u ljeto 2026. godine, čime će se ujedno zaključiti mandat maestra Ivana Repušića.

Vezano uz suradnju na području kulture i umjetnosti, posebno se ističe:

- Nastavak suradnje i razmjene informacija o mogućnosti razmjene stručnjaka u područjima bibliotekarstva, muzeologije, arhivske djelatnosti, zaštite kulturne baštine i podvodne arheologije te povezivanja ustanova i stručnjaka na ostvarenju zajedničkih projekata.
- Suradnja i razmjena stručnjaka i umjetnika u rezidencijalnim programima u području vizualnih umjetnosti i književnosti te izvedbenim umjetnostima, s naglaskom na mogućnost izravne suradnje hrvatskih i bavarskih kazališta i ustanova te razmjeni gostovanja glazbenika i umjetničkih ansambala.
- Nastavak suradnje hrvatskih i bavarskih stručnjaka na proširenju nominacije za upis na UNESCO-ov Popis svjetske baštine za Granice Rimskog Carstva – Dunavski limes (zapadni dio).

### **III. Gospodarstvo, energetika i industrija**

U području gospodarstva, energetike i industrije dogovoren je nastavak suradnje na projektu proširenja LNG terminala na Krku i pripadajućih plinovoda, uz redovitu razmjenu informacija o napretku projekta kao ključne komponente za opskrbu Europe energijom s juga.

Također, naglasak je na daljnjoj suradnji sektorskih komora i institucija te podršci poslovnim povezivanjima između bavarskih i hrvatskih tvrtki, jačanju političkog dijaloga i bilateralne suradnje. Posebna pažnja posvećena je razvoju strukovnog obrazovanja i usavršavanja. U ovom je kontekstu dogovoren i nastavak partnerske suradnje Obrtničke komore za München i Gornju Bavarsku i Hrvatske obrtničke komore u području rada komorskog sustava, posebice strukovnog obrazovanja za obrtnička zanimanja, kao i putem razmjene iskustava i znanja, zajedničkih projekata i sudjelovanja na sajmovima.

Suradnja s bavarskim partnerima u području kružnog gospodarstva i učinkovitosti resursa postaje važan prioritet, s ciljem jačanja globalne konkurentnosti i osiguravanja održivog gospodarskog rasta.

Daljnji razvoj suradnje planira se i u segmentu vodika i obnovljivih izvora energije, s naglaskom na optimalno korištenje geotermalne energije. Aktivnosti uključuju razmjenu iskustava vezano uz ciljeve Europskog zelenog plana, razmatranje mogućnosti partnerstava i investicija u projekte geotermalne energije te razmjenu znanja o vodiku i drugim obnovljivim izvorima energije.

Dogovoren je nastavak jačanja suradnje u automobilskoj industriji, s fokusom na razvoj proizvodne suradnje, digitalnih i IT rješenja te podršku elektrifikaciji i održivim tehnologijama.

Razmijenjene su informacije o aktualnim i planiranim projektima u okviru programa europske teritorijalne suradnje i makroregionalnih strategija u finansijskoj perspektivi 2021. – 2027. u kojima surađuju hrvatski i bavarski partneri. Posebno su istaknuti projekti: DECORATOR, DiSTT, HyEfRe, Danube Wood(s)route, IntegrAGE, Greenhealth, Leeway, Carbon Farming CE i Circular DigiBuild.

#### **IV. Zaštita okoliša, poljoprivreda, vodno gospodarstvo, turizam, sport i zdravstvo**

Hrvatski i bavarski partneri nastavljaju uspješnu suradnju u koordinaciji Prioritetnog područja 06 – Biološka raznolikost, krajobrazi te kvaliteta zraka i tla u okviru Strategije EU-a za dunavsku regiju (EUSDR). Također, nastavlja se suradnja u području održivog upravljanja vodama s ciljem jačanja stručnih kapaciteta u tijelima nadležnim za upravljanje vodama.



Dogovoreno je intenziviranje dijaloga o novoj Zajedničkoj poljoprivrednoj politici EU u okolnostima globalnih izazova koje izazivaju rat u Ukrajini i aktualne trgovinske prepreke, te potrebe osiguranja prehrambene sigurnosti zemalja. Potvrđen je interes obje strane za nastavkom konkretne suradnje u poljoprivrednom i prehrambenom sektoru, s naglaskom na proizvode zaštićene oznakama izvornosti i zemljopisnog podrijetla, te prijenos i razmjena znanja i iskustava u području stočarstva.

U području turizma, sporta i zdravstva dogovoren je nastavak suradnje sukladno prijedlozima radnog programa.
